## **CREDENTIALING CRITERIA**

- 1. Name of Position/procedure : Clinical Deep Brain Stimulation Neurophysiologist
- 2. **Back ground Information** (if applicable)- explanation of the procedure: The neurophysiologist assists in the Deep Brain Stimulation procedure by providing feedback to the neurosurgeon regarding placement of the intra-cranial probe, along with the selection and post-op monitoring of this population.
- 3. **Involved Specialties:** Neurology, Neurosurgery, Psychiatry
- 4. Minimum Threshold:
  - a. **Education** Masters / Doctorate degree
  - b. Minimal current experience
    - i. Familiar with Medtronic, Abbott, Boston Scientific and Neuropace Deep
       Brain Stimulation systems
  - c. **References** 3 letters of reference to attest to competency, 1 of which must be from a physician in the specialty of Neurosurgery
- 5. **FPPE / Proctoring** direct observation of the first 5 procedures
- 6. **Reappointment** <u>must document a minimum of 12 procedures as the monitor for</u>
  Deep Brain Stimulation
- 7. Clinical Privileges:
  - a. Participation in Pre-op planning
  - b. Guiding Microelectrode recordings during Deep Brain Stimulation
  - c. Participate in Long term care post-operative management
  - d. <u>Develop and participate in research programs</u>
- 8. **Collaborative Agreement**: Must have a collaborating agreement with an Active Staff
