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<u>PURPOSE</u>: To define the qualifications and ensure quality and safety in pediatric gastroenterology procedures at the K. Hovnanian Children's Hospital. Pediatric age 0 to 21 years.

<u>SCOPE:</u> Tests included in this policy and procedure include all upper and lower endoscopy, capsule studies, gastrostomy tube care, manometry, foreign body removal, TPN management, and interpretation of pH probe tests

<u>POLICY STATEMENT</u>: The K. Hovnanian Children's Hospital Pediatric Gastroenterology staff will exercise the privilege to perform the procedures and management listed under scope above. Eligibility:

- Must be board eligible or certified in Pediatric Gastroenterology
- Be a member in good standing of the medical staff of JSUMC/K. Hovnanian Children's Hospital
- Have demonstrated professional behavior and the ability to work collaboratively with peers and staff.
- May begin as a new member of the staff, during the Provisional period, after completing a FPPE of at least 5 proctored procedures of each type and monitored for 3 TPN order sets.

Procedure:

- 1. Be able and willing to read and interpret studies for all patients
- 2. Be part of a call system that provides continuous coverage 24/7
- 3. Be part of a peer review process for any issues or complications that arise
